Affiliated trade association dues are not used for lobbying expenses.

Note: Dues paid to the Construction Employers Association are not considered a charitable tax deduction. A portion of your dues are considered a lobbying expenditure and not deductible for tax purposes. We have allowed for 50% of the amount of CEA dues allocable to lobbying expenses. However, they are generally considered an ordinary and necessary business expense subject to the above rules.

DONATING YOUR CEA DUES TO THE CONSTRUCTION EMPLOYERS PAC

The State of Ohio permits you to use your annual dues as a PAC contribution. You can do so if your company is a sole proprietorship, a general partnership, limited partnership, limited partnership association, limited liability partnership, or a limited liability company. Ohio Rev. Code 3517.10. If your company is a corporation, a related company you control, you can do so on your company's behalf.
