The Opportunity Corridor Section 2 involves the construction of a new roadway from E. 93rd Street to E. 105th Street; reconstruction of portions of E. 93rd Street, E. 105th Street, Quincy Avenue and Quebec Avenue; reconstruction of the E. 105th Street bridge over GCRTA and Norfolk Southern north of Quincy Avenue; extension of the existing GCRTA rail platform; and building demolitions in the City of Cleveland. Construction is expected to begin late-fall 2016 and be complete in the fall of 2018.
