MSDS Updating & Archiving – One of the biggest challenges in maintaining MSDS inventories is ensuring that the MSDS's contained in the database are the most current available. MSDS BinderWorks™ receives regular updates from manufacturers. Also, all MSDS information is archived, which enables subscribers to comply with the 30-year archiving rule mandated by OSHA. Email notifications and PDF downloads of updated MSDS's are sent quarterly.

Hardcopy Books & CD-ROM's – Establishing an electronic MSDS inventory is easy. Maintaining an up-to-date hardcopy book is not. In order to bridge this gap, subscribers can create electronic MSDS inventories that can be used to publish a custom hardcopy book.
